

EMMANUELLE BRIAT
Visual Artist



As a visual artist working with plant materials, I develop a practice based on the use of natural elements that questions our relationship with nature.

A multidisciplinary artist and advocate for the living world, I seek to gently and kindly shift preconceptions by fostering immersion—an encounter with the plant realm—through monumental installations, scenography, performance art, photography, video, botanical compositions, and interdisciplinary collaborations.

I weave, compose, intertwine, and shape—much like a choreography—the elements I gather **in situ** (and mindfully), revealing their unique characteristics, textures, and growth patterns. Since the early 2000s, I have been acquiring knowledge of both European and exotic flora while exploring plant movement and longevity. I create hybrid forms—without genetic modification—to offer a sensory, empathetic, and poetic experience. I share my feelings and my perspective on nature, landscapes, and architecture, while reflecting on societal attitudes toward the living world.

Vines, the integration of plant life, and the concept of connection are recurring themes in my work. I strive to restore human bonds with nature and to evoke the interdependencies between living beings. I explore plant memories and imagine botanical narratives, staging them to depict a nature that is simultaneously real and unreal. People who encounter my work often share with me the memories it stirs within them. Furthermore, personal and professional experiences in France and abroad have introduced me to customs and traditions where nature holds a significant place.

Thus, the landscapes I discovered in childhood—memories of beaches, gardens, and forests—along with the people I have met, have shaped my vision and the way I engage with the plant world.



FRESQUES VÉGÉTALES

Two installations made from Canary Island palm and agave reference the geometric patterns found in Moroccan craftsmanship, notably in zellige tilework, zouaq painted wood, decoration, mashrabiya (wooden lattice screens), and gebs (carved plasterwork).

The plant materials were collected on site.

Two traditional techniques were employed: weaving agave leaves and braiding palm fibers to create the rings.

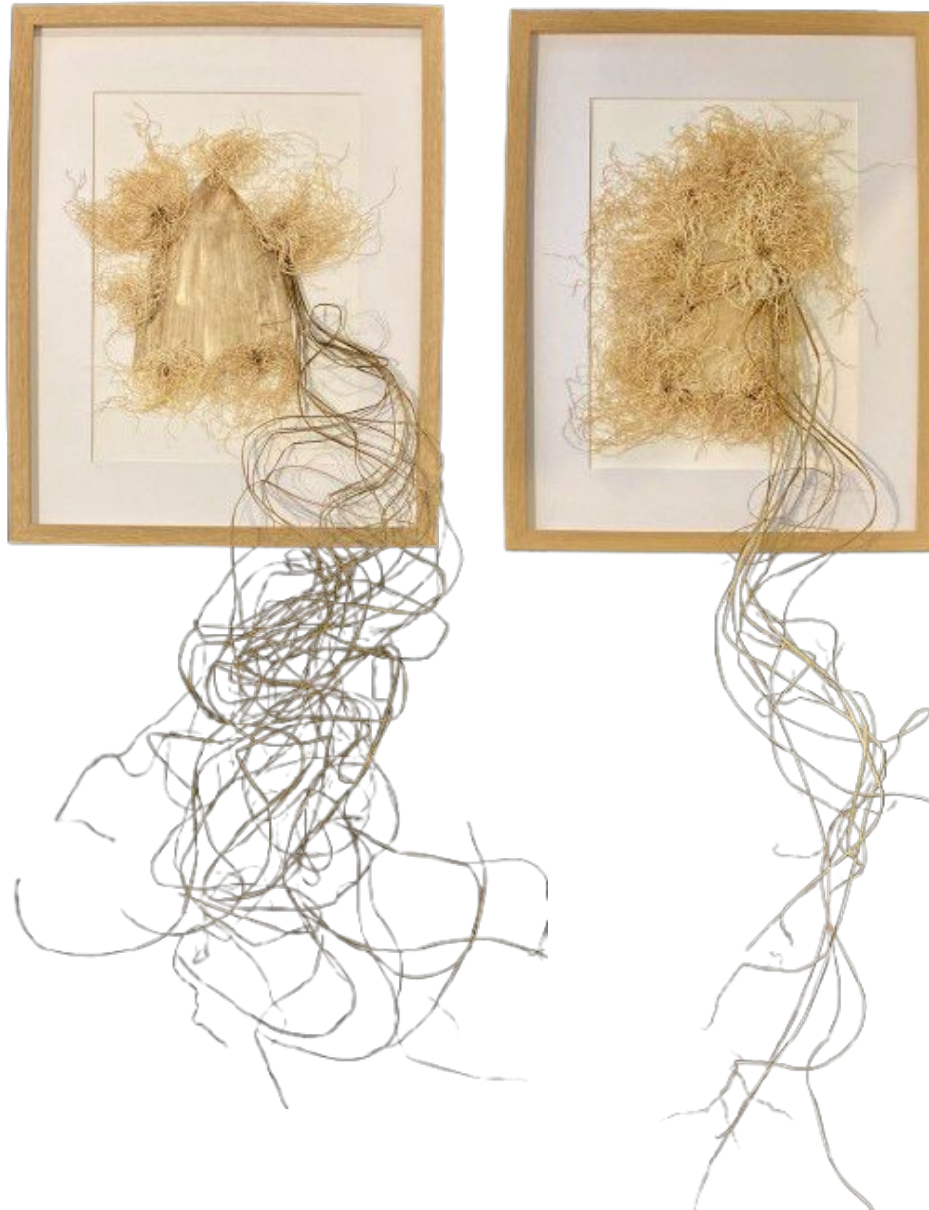

Nourished by her experiences in contact with a luxuriant nature, still somewhat untouched by man, imbued with memories of the rebirth of a family garden in Brittany, Emmanuelle Briat establishes an attentive and caring relationship with plants. The artist listens to the natural elements that she encounters during her travels, her explorations of the land and invitations to work in situ. She observes the ability of plants to adapt following domestication and climate change. Fascinated by the strength of natural elements, phenomena that can take over, she composes with plants, installations that express the power of plants to insert themselves, to take root. Her explorations of environments, whether natural or developed by the hand of man, lead her to glean natural treasures. Emmanuelle works as much in interiors as in open-air spaces, in both urban and rural contexts. Plants will outlive us and their properties, origins and development still have much to teach us, Emmanuelle Briat tells us. This time of reflection is essential to her. The artist keeps moments of life in Africa deep within her. The use of collected natural materials and their assembly echo ancestral construction techniques. By walking through the places, meeting and touring her works in situ, we can feel a presence with which to enter into a relationship. When she intervenes in heritage sites, the artist investigates, studies and takes the time to appreciate the architecture in order to detect the history of the human imprint. She gives as much importance to understanding the place where she creates as to the intrinsic qualities of the elements she takes from the site. Her discoveries of the history of the site, its landscaping, the use of plants in the past and according to cultures, are at the origin of her installations. Both restrained and offbeat, they resonate with the external elements. Emmanuelle collaborates with plants. Some are recurrent such as bamboo, willow, clematis, phormium, "degenerate holly", ivy, used for their property both solid and flexible. Her sculptures and installations are open to the environment in which they are located. The assembled materials draw shapes. Our movement and our curiosity are then solicited. At the castle of Seneffe, in Belgium (2022), her installations invited us to understand the design of the park. Passionate, guided by her sensitivity, Emmanuelle Briat refines her approach and her work with plants by studying the behavior of plants. She is attentive to their structure, their mobility and flexibility. The human body and the body of the plant connect gently. Her works make visible the specificities of these living beings while encouraging us to dream and restore our ability to be amazed on a daily basis. Her installations notably combine geometry, echoing human action and organicity, the irregularity of the shape of the plant, Flux # Reflux (Vign'art, Magenta, near Epernay, 2023).

Since 2021, the octahedron has appeared in her work as a visual artist. This geometric figure recalls the structure of a diamond. Both flexible and rigid, her sculptures and installations play on a tension, a balance specific to the ecosystem.

Some, such as *La Maison chantante*, (Marcoussis, 91, in 2021), evoke traditional habitats. Their presence suggests the strength of natural phenomena as well as the resistance of constructions. Recently, during an invitation to the Château de Bosc (Gard, 2023), she discovered the plastic possibilities that vine shoots allow.

In short, her installations invite us to be as close as possible to the plant, both physically and mentally. In her works on the scale of a place, plants seem to grow without limit, like their development in the environments where they grow in their natural state. The artist continues this approach by creating plant scenographies, combining light, sound and plants. Natural curiosities, as she assembles them, transform the architecture of the place. Visitors are then immersed in a mysterious atmosphere, in which nature seems abundant. Like an inner journey, this experience tends to provide sensations and activate memories.

Since 2018, Emmanuelle Briat has crystallized her thoughts and attention to others with *Manifeste Naturel*, a project in collaboration with the dancer Rozenn Dubreuil: an encounter with a plant being with whom to enter into a relationship. Contacts and caresses tend to activate the sensitivity of the passerby or spectator. This work, on the border between the visual arts and the performing arts, offers a moment of sharing, of kindness towards oneself and otherness. Like symbiosis, interactions within an ecosystem, *Manifeste naturel* continues at the crossroads of disciplines in a fertile dynamic.

The artist's passion for the plant world leads her in particular to deepen her knowledge of plant behavior. Her works activate in us the possibility of listening to the language of plants. They make visible the specificities of plant life while inviting us to dream and restore our ability to marvel on a daily basis. Her projects thus inspire us with a kind approach to plants.

Finally, Emmanuelle Briat's artistic work also encourages us to question the relationships between the natural element as a material, the place where it was taken and the site where the work comes to life.

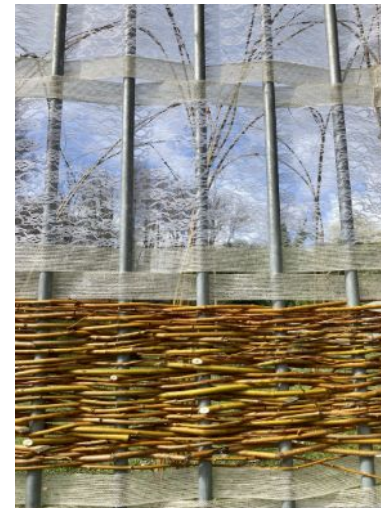
